

**Personal and Permanent Undertaking to the Court

- (a) She will comply with the letter and the spirit of the September 27, 2007 order of Associate Chief Justice Cunningham (the “September 27, 2007 Order”);
- (b) She will not attempt to “re-secure” or in any way occupy the Clarendon Minerals Site and the exploration property;
- (c) She will not engage in any activity that directly or indirectly blocks Frontenac Ventures Corporation representatives from bringing a drill on the Clarendon Minerals Site and the exploration property;
- (d) She will use best efforts to ensure that Ardoch Algonquin First Nation members comply with the September 27, 2007 Order including: (a) not coming within 200 metres of the gate of the Clarendon Minerals Site or the exploration property, with the exception of *bona fide* hunting, trapping or fishing activities during the applicable season in groups of four people or less and with the exception of travel in the normal course on Highway 509; (b) not attempting to re-secure the property; and (c) not blocking Frontenac Ventures Corporation from bringing a drill on the property;
- (e) She will not solicit or encourage third parties to engage in any activity prevented by the September 27, 2007 Order. “Third parties” include members of the Shabot Obaadjiwan First Nation, members of other First Nations including Six Nations and Mohawks, “settlers”, including members of CCAMU and environmental groups;
- (f) She will post a transcript of the undertaking given to the court in the Ardoch Algonquin First Nation band office (or equivalent) and on the Ardoch Algonquin First Nation website; and
- (g) She will not bring any motions to vary the September 27, 2007 Order or the exploration schedule or any other motion before contempt #2 is disposed of.
